2. Time schedule			
2.1 The dissertation project should be finished in years.			
2.2 The doctoral student commits himself to report to his/her supervisor about the status of			
his/her work, the adherence of the time schedule as well as participation in scientific events			
and interdisciplinary qualification offers.			
The supervisors commit themselves to provide subject-specific advice to the PhD students.			
They are responsible for the quality management of the dissertation. They structure the			
dissertation project in a way that it can be finished within the planned period and provide			
support for the adherence of the time schedule. This also includes (interdisciplinary) career			
support and networking in the scientific community. There will be detailed discussions at			
intervals of months regarding the PhD progress, the results of which will be written			
down.
